
What does a camp and conference professional really do?

LODGING AND TRANSPORTATION

For over 50 years, <u>DuBois Center</u> has served as the summer camp and retreat center of the United Church of Christ in southern Illinois. It is nestled amidst 308 wooded acres, two lakes, open meadows, and countless trails During our stay, the Focus Event will be housed in Hickory Lodge. This two-story structure has many guest rooms (with hall bathrooms), a quiet patio, and a great view of the lake. Linens will be provided to participants. If you have dietary restrictions, please let us know upon registration.

The nearest airport is Lambert - St. Louis International Airport (STL), which is about 90 minutes away from camp. We will provide a shuttle from the airport by 6:00pm, so please plan to arrive by 5:30pm on Friday. The program will begin Friday evening with some getting acquainted activities at 8:00pm (dinner is on your own). We ask those driving to DuBois Center to arrive between 6:30pm and 7:30pm on Friday night. The program will end with breakfast and morning worship, so the shuttle back to the airport will leave around 10:00am on Sunday. Please schedule flights no earlier than 12:30pm.
