### DuBois Center Leadership Training for Selected Teens (completed grades 10-12)

Those selected for the CIT program enjoy a great – yet very different – week of camp, while gaining skills that will help them grow as positive Christian leaders. Creating a fun, safe environment, managing camper behavior and teaching basic camp skills are all part of the curriculum.

Working with younger campers, CIT teammates gain valuable practical experience. They also peek “behind the scenes” at DuBois and develop a sense of community.
