

# Greetings Horse Campers!



Whether you are attending Pony Express, Horsin' Around, Saddle 'Em Up, or Wrangler, we have some special notes and instructions for you.

**First, here are some additional items to bring:**

1. **MORE JEANS** – Yours will get hot and sweaty after just one day so bring 3-5 pairs for full week camps and 2-3 pairs for Pony Express.
2. **YOUR BOOTS** – If you own riding boots or shoes you are welcome to bring them. If not, we have ones at the barn you can borrow.

**If you bring your own boots or shoes for riding, they need to have a smooth sole with at least a ½" heel. No sandals of any kind are allowed for any activities in the barn.**

3. **MORE SOCKS** – These get hot and sweaty in riding boots, so bring at least 11 pairs for full-week camps and 7 pairs for Pony Express.
4. **BANDANA** – Optional, but a cold, wet bandana does feel nice around the neck when it's hot.
