

Activity Options

(Effective January 2018)

(A minimum of 2-4 weeks advance notice is required for activities requiring specialized staff.)

NOTE: For the purpose of Activity Options, tenting groups are considered to be "day groups." Part of the fee for overnight accommodations in the cottages and Hickory Lodge supports reduced activity fees.

Canoes & Jon Boats: PFDs/Life jackets are provided and required for each person in a water craft. Prices are per 60-75 minute session.

Overnight Groups: \$30 per session for boats and certified DuBois Center Watercraft Lifeguard

\$25 per session for overnight guest groups with own certified leadership

Day Use Groups: \$45 per session for boats and certified DuBois Center Watercraft Lifeguard

\$40 per session for day use only guests with own certified leadership

NOTE: Currently certified Lifeguards or Watercraft Lifeguards are REQUIRED for YOUTH and FAMILY boating. There are also supervision requirements for Adult Groups. Orientation by DuBois Center Staff and a copy of certifications required. For more details contact our office.

Campfires: NO CHARGE for overnight guests – if a moderate amount of wood is used. We lay the fire; you light it and put it out at the end of your time there. Groups provide own utensils and items for s'mores or other roasts, unless arrangements have been made in advance with our office.

Hayrides: 18-20 persons per wagon, with option of 1 or 2 wagons per ride

Overnight Groups: \$28 for one wagon, second wagon is \$14

Day Use Groups: \$40 for one wagon for day/night use only guests, second wagon is \$14

(includes campfire before or after the hay ride)

Horseback Riding: Group minimum = 6 riders. Maximum per ride = 12 persons.

Typical ride times: 9:15am, 10:30am, 1:00pm, 2:15pm, 3:30pm. One-hour session with orientation in the arena and trail ride.

Overnight Groups: \$18 per person Day Use Groups: \$22 per person

In addition to traditional trail rides, options such as Boy and Girl Scout badge work and "Horse Sense" sessions can be arranged for an additional fee. Contact the office for details and prices.

Pontoon Boat Ride (seasonal): 15-20 minute cruise around the lake with our driver.

PFDs/Life jackets (provided by camp) are required for everyone. Maximum per ride = 8 persons.

Activity Options at DuBois Center - Page 2

For all swimming activities, children under age 12 must be supervised by a parent or a designated adult from the guest group.

Swimming – General (Memorial Day – Labor Day): General swimming takes place in our designated, roped-off swim area. Orientation will be provided, and all rules must be followed. Limit is 50 people. Supervision is provided by DuBois Center staff who are certified lifeguards and trained lookouts.

Overnight Groups: \$50 per hour for 1-25 people \$80 per hour for 26-35 people

\$100 per hour for 36-50 people

Day Use Groups: \$60 per hour for 1-25 people \$95 per hour for 26-35 people

\$120 per hour for 36-50 people

NOTE: PFDs/Life jackets are provided and required for each person swimming or utilizing water toys, such as the water mat and the FFFFun because they are located in open water.

Swimming – Rope Swing (Memorial Day – Labor Day): The Rope Swing is a large "inflatable" in the middle of our lake. *Up to 8 can be accommodated at one time; minimum age is 8 years old.* Two groups can rotate "through" this activity in an hour. It works best and is most cost effective to schedule this activity at the same time as a general swim because fewer additional staff are needed if the swim area is already open.

Overnight Groups – if swim area is scheduled: \$25 per hour for up to 8 people at a time \$65 per hour for up to 8 people at a time \$30 per hour for up to 8 people at a time \$30 per hour for up to 8 people at a time

Day Use Groups – if swim area is NOT scheduled: \$75 per hour for up to 8 people at a time

Swimming — Water Mat (Memorial Day — Labor Day): All ages are welcome on the mat. For this activity, the ideal group size is 8-15 people, though up to 18 can be accommodated. The lifeguard has the right to limit the number of individuals on the mat based on size of participants and their behavior. Supervision is provided by DuBois Center staff who are certified lifeguards and trained lookouts.

Overnight Groups: \$50 per hour for 1-18 people Day Use Groups: \$60 per hour for 1-18 people

Team Building: Group minimum = 8 participants

Overnight Groups: \$25 per hour or \$2 per person per hour (whichever is greater)

Day Use Groups: \$30 per hour or \$2.50 per person per hour (whichever is greater)

Teams Course: 2.5-3 hour sessions with our instructor(s). Up to two "groups" can be accommodated at a time. Group minimum = 8 participants. Ideal group size is 12-14 participants. **Overnight Groups:** \$9.50 per person **Day Use Groups:** \$12 per person

IN ADDITION, we have a number of recreational opportunities available at no cost. Some need to be pre-scheduled to allow for adequate set-up time and avoid conflicts with other groups.
