Beginner-friendly with some advanced options for more experienced equestrians. It's a day of bonding with the ponies including grooming, tacking, riding and other horse activities.



PRICE INCLUDES: Two nights lodging in heated accommodations, five meals, program activities and supplies. **Horseback riding is optional** with an additional fee of \$18 per person for a trail ride with orientation in the arena, or \$9 for a guided arena ride that is geared for younger riders.
